Dear Parents/Guardians,

November 3, 2021

The Bangor School Department in collaboration with Bangor Public Health will be offering vaccination clinics to administer the COVID-19 vaccine for children 5 through 11 years of age. Children will be offered the Pfizer-BionTech Covid-19 Vaccine to prevent coronavirus disease 2019 (Covid-19) caused by SARS-CoV-2. The vaccine is a two-shot series and following the schedule is extremely important. Please be sure to mark your calendars for the date and time to be sure your child is present to receive their second dose.

The first clinic is being offered after school to encourage parents to bring their children. The additional clinics will be offered in our Pre-K - 5 schools. Those students who were unable to attend one of the after school clinics (11/8) and have returned a signed release will receive their vaccination while at school, be supervised for 15 minutes, and then return to the learning environment. The clinics will be held on the following dates, times, and locations:

WEEK 1

Monday, November 8th

Cohen and Doughty from 3:00 PM - 4:30 PM. Parents will transport, sign paperwork onsite, and remain present.

Tuesday, November 9th - Those students with signed releases returned to school by Monday November 8th will receive their first dose.

9:00 AM – 10:30 AM at Fruit Street School (Fruit Street School students)

11:00 AM -12:30 PM at Abraham Lincoln School (Abraham Lincoln students)

WEEK 2

Monday, November 15th - Those students with signed releases returned to school by Friday November 12th will receive their first dose.

9:00 AM -11:00 AM at Fourteenth Street and Fairmount Schools (Fairmount and Fourteenth Street students)

1:00 PM – 3:00 PM at Vine Street School (Vine Street students)

Tuesday, November 16th - Those students with signed releases returned to school by Friday November 12th will receive their first dose.

9:00 AM – 11:00 AM at Downeast School (Downeast students)

1:00 PM – 3:00 PM at Mary Snow School (Mary Snow students)

WEEK 3

Monday, November 22nd and Tuesday, November 23rd

Catch up clinics—Time and location to be determined

SECOND DOSE

Week 1--November 29th and 30th - same schedule as above

Week 2--December 6th and 7th - same schedule as above

Week 3--December 13th and 14th - time and location to be determined
